Who we are

We are the British designers, manufacturers, printers and finishers of all the badges you will find in this brochure, specialising in sustainable materials. All stages of production are in house, backed by a multi award winning customer service team to help with your orders. No air miles are involved in the production of our goods, no finished product is brought in to simply be decorated in the UK, everything here is made from raw planks and sheet materials from scratch.

Sustainable British Manufacturing

We firmly believe that sustainable products come from a sustainable manufacturing base, but there is currently no standard definition of sustainable manufacturing. Sustainable British manufacturing for us is the safe production of our products through economically and environmentally sound processes, using ethically sourced materials with print and production techniques that minimise negative impacts while conserving natural resources and energy. Sustainable manufacturing also provides benefits to our employees and the wider community and ensures product safety for our customers. Much more is explained on pages 17-18.

Supporting a Circular Economy



Traditional manufacturing is described as linear, where natural resources are turned into products that ultimately become landfill – often summarised as take, make and waste. We believe however that we have a responsibility for the whole life cycle of our products, all the way from design to end of useful life and beyond – a circular manufacturing model. But we also go further than that as we are turning waste into thousands of trees and tonnes of carbon reduction. Our circular model looks at manufacturing in this different way, much of it based on the 3R's – REDUCE, REUSE and RECYCLE (read more... p18).



How with your help by the end of 2023 we will have planted over 40,000 trees and offset over 1000 tonnes of carbon.

We have introduced a unique initiative which directly supports environmental projects from the sale of factory waste materials, the reuse or recycling of key parts from our British made products and the promotion of changing to more sustainable natural materials. Your product choices can make a real difference. Every year we aim to plant over 20,000 trees and offset over 1000 tonnes of carbon with your help. No loss in quality, no additional cost to you, no increased lead times, just environmental benefits from informed decision making.



For every badge we make from natural materials, wood and bamboo, we will give 1p towards tree planting with Ecologi. By the end of 2023 we aim to have 40,000 trees in our forest with them and will continue to plant at least 20,000 trees every year.



For every single badge we make from aluminium we will give 1p and for every 1000 button badges we make we will give £1.00. This money all goes towards Community Based Projects with Ecologi that also offset carbon, thus contributing to our aim to offset at least 1000 tonnes of carbon this year and each year after that. Examples of these Community Based Projects are the supply of clean water and the provision of more efficient, cleaner stoves in developing countries. Projects like these lead to healthier lives and a reduction in use of biomass.



In our manufacturing we do of course generate waste and the scrap metals we produce from badge production have value. We've decided to put all the money raised from the sale of scrap into Renewable Energy based carbon offsets. In 2022 we offset over 100 tonnes of carbon simply from doing this.



Wood and bamboo will biodegrade but not only do metal items have scrap value at end of life, items like name badge magnets and plastic components can also be reused which is the best thing of all to do with them. Our simple pledge is that if we've made it and you're uncertain of the best way to recycle it then return it to us and we will take it from there for the most efficient reuse and recycling. Any money we make from scrap sales or save from reusing parts gets spent on more carbon offsets and tree planting - all we ask is you pay the postage.

Flags

It's possible to add country flags to personalised name badges as a variable print option on full colour print to denote the languages the wearer speaks. We provide a spreadsheet with a drop down list of flags so that we can automate the print and minimise additional costs.



Photos

Individual photos can be added to full colour printed badges for greatly increased security. The photos must be supplied to our exact specification - if you require us to crop and touch up random photos we can, but additional costs will apply.



Pronouns

The option of adding pronouns to name badges is a simple way to make sure everyone's identities are included and respected by employees and customers alike. An additional pronoun column on your spreadsheet can be easily set up and tailored to your individual requirements.

Stock call off



Pay monthly accounts

Anyone with an annual name badge requirement of 500 badges or more can make the biggest savings of all by paying monthly in arrears for their name badge usage. These ongoing supply arrangements are always organised online to ensure the least admin involvement of all - simple monthly invoices with a detailed management report confirms usage.



What makes our button badges different as a more sustainable product...

- ✓ For every 1000 badges we make, and we make millions every year, £1.00 is given to community based projects with Ecologi, helping support people and planet
- ✓ No air miles - many button badges sold in the UK are actually airfreighted in which is completely unnecessary
- ✓ We only print on recycled paper from certified stock
- ✓ Our metal backed button badges (25mm, 32mm, 38mm, 45mm and 55mm) use only British made components from part recycled material.
- ✓ Metal backed button badges are very easy to recycle and can simply be placed in any household or office can / metal recycling bin
- ✓ Our End of Life Product Return Scheme applies to the plastic backed button badges where we can either reuse the plastic components or separate the elements for efficient recycling.
- ✓ All of our metal waste from component manufacture is also recycled for zero landfill manufacturing and we sell that waste to purchase carbon offsets supporting renewable energy projects
- ✓ Our plastic moulded parts on the clip backed and 75mm badges are also UK manufactured and use a large percentage of recycled material
- ✓ All our plastic waste from component manufacture is also recycled



Sustainable Materials



Moso® Bamboo

This attractive material is our most eco friendly.

- All MOSO® material is made in production facilities that are ISO 9001 quality and ISO 14001 environmental third party certified and comply with the most stringent international standards.
- All adhesives used by MOSO® easily meet the very strict E1 class following the EN717 standard with respect to formaldehyde emissions and all MOSO®'s solid bamboo materials are proven and certified to be carbon neutral or better over their full life cycle.

MOSO® bamboo combines all of the virtues of hardwoods with the immense growing capacity of the highly renewable giant MOSO® bamboo species and can therefore act as a green carbon negative alternative material. MOSO® bamboo is one of the quickest growing plants in the world and can grow up to 50 cm a day before reaching a height of twenty metres. After maturing over four to five years it's cut down, but amazingly the act of cutting down mature cane stimulates the plant to grow more canes. The result is the plant itself never needs to be dug up and so retains any carbon captured.



Our Moso® bamboo has warm 'caramel' tones. Bamboo is soft enough to get a beautiful deep engraving whilst hard enough not to burn and char. Bamboo has good ink adhesion, digitally prints well with good color accuracy.



Wood

We work with oak, cherry, maple and walnut woods - they provide a nice spectrum of natural wood tones to choose from, from the very light (maple) to the darker, more chocolate brown (walnut). Each wood type may have small inconsistencies i.e. lighter spots (sapwood) and/or darker spots (burl or crotch) and also different grain structures, ranging from wider open grain (oak) to more closed, smoother grains (cherry, maple). These characteristics are part of the natural beauty of each piece of wood and add greatly to the individuality and uniqueness of the finished product which is why our customers love it and will always choose it over more uniform man-made materials. Wood is inherently renewable and sustainable if properly sourced and managed and we only use wood from these fully certified sustainable supplies. Wood also has a lighter carbon footprint than almost all synthetic materials and, as a natural organic material, can be easily recycled or naturally decompose over time with no harm to ecosystems or the environment.



Oak is light to medium brown in colour with varied and openly porous grain patterns. Engraving produces a distinctive 'burnt' effect quite different to other wood types but with a good level of contrast. All wood types have good ink adhesion, digitally print well with good color accuracy.

Sustainable Materials




Steel

All our steel is part recycled material and the environmental benefits of steel include the fact that the material can be recycled with ease anywhere in the UK. Most button badge suppliers buy in their components, many from overseas, but we make all of ours at our factory from steel coils for the lowest possible carbon footprint. As with aluminium, our zero-waste button badge component manufacturing allows for the sale of all excess steel from our factory for recycling, the sale of which is all spent on purchasing Gold Standard carbon offsets.

At end of life our metal backed button badges (25mm, 32mm, 38mm, 45mm and 55mm pin backed) can simply be placed in with your normal home or office can recycling where magnets separate them from the aluminium cans.

The 75mm plastic backed pin badges and the plastic backed clip badges can be returned to our recycling base and we will separate the steel and plastic elements, recycling the steel and recycling or reusing the plastic components.

Scrap steel sales form a large part of our annual 1000 tonnes of carbon reduction target. Simply by choosing our steel backed button badges you will be not only choosing an easily recycled item made from part recycled material but that purchase will be making a positive contribution to environmental projects.



Aluminium

Aluminium is an amazing material as it is infinitely recyclable and can be reformed endlessly whilst retaining its material properties indefinitely. All of the aluminium we use in our products has recycled content and it's one of the most sustainable materials on the market today. In addition, our zero-waste manufacturing processes allow for the collection of all unused 'offcuts' of aluminium for recycling as well. Recycling aluminium saves about 90% of the energy it takes to make new aluminium as well as helping to reduce the demand for mining the bauxite ore needed to produce new aluminium. Due to a combination of the wide and varied applications for aluminium, the commercial and domestic infrastructure to recycle aluminium is continually growing and increased public awareness of its sustainable credentials means aluminium has become a very attractive and popular material choice. Our products

We ensure our products are safe and fit for purpose. We comply with REACH and all other UK regulations relating to the safety of what we make. Our company is ISO9001 quality and ISO14001 environmental certified and we will ensure that the systems and processes are in place so that the product you receive is what you expect.

Our materials

We will research and promote the use of the most sustainable materials available, paying a premium where necessary for suppliers and materials with proven environmental credentials. Our choice of materials



used in these products is fully explained in this brochure.

Driving innovation

Every year we will release new products and develop our services to offer our customers industry leading solutions. We are the originators of many innovative and unique products and have pioneered plastic free packaging and individual product personalisation in our industry with easy online solutions.



Minimising waste

We minimise the waste we produce and recycle what we can wherever possible. We will prefer the use of materials where all manufacturing waste has a secondary use or will be recycled, such as products made from aluminium, bamboo, wood and recycled acrylic.

We have also reduced our paper usage by approximately 75% in the last few years and will continue to develop our internal technology to run our factory as paper free as possible.

Infrastructure

We invest in the long term future



of the company. In recent years not only have we invested in new print and production equipment, we also extended our factory by 6,000 square feet to ensure we had the space to grow and improve our UK manufacturing base.

Packaging

Your goods will be despatched in completely plastic free packaging, made from different papers and card that is easily recycled in any home or office. We even go as far as to use plastic free tape on our boxes.

The UK economy

We pay our taxes, all of them, on time and comply with all laws and regulations relevant to our business which supports the wider UK economy. We use UK suppliers wherever we can, preferring to buy as locally to our factory as possible to further support the regional economy.

Our customers

We operate to an industry leading set of service level standards to supply you with the accurate information you need in a timely manner. Customers

Our commitment to sustainable British manufacturing

will be treated fairly, with respect and if we get something wrong we will admit it and put it right.



Energy & resources

Our factory is heated by a biomass boiler using only pellets made as a bi-product of UK pallet making. Low energy lighting is used throughout, we are well insulated and when machinery needs replacing, energy efficiency will play a major part in choosing alternatives. Very little water is required in our production but use is always monitored for savings to be made.

Our suppliers

We also treat our suppliers fairly and with respect, looking to forge long term partnerships with like minded companies who reject any form of bribery and can demonstrate there is no slavery within their supply chain.

Our employees

We provide a safe and friendly place to work with good working conditions. All those who work in our factory

have a contract of employment with us and comprehensive staff training and handbook outlining all aspects of working for the company. We aim to provide opportunities within the company for those who wish to progress and full training is always provided. Those responsible for factory health and safety are fully trained to ensure safe working practices throughout. We only create secure employment for the long term and do not use agencies. We employ over 50 people and will only create new jobs when we know they will be secure.



Real world recycling

Many materials claim to be recyclable but cannot currently be put into kerbside bin collections, or won't be recovered as they are deemed to be of little or no commercial value. As a result, we focus on using materials in our products which can be easily recycled when it reaches the end of its useful life.

However, in practice this is not a simple, straight forward process. For example, some of our products have



fixings or use different material types which confuses their classification for recycling. Some councils allow small mixed metal items to be put in kerbside recycling bins, others will have dedicated mixed metal skips at the local recycling centre. If you would like to ensure your goods purchased from us are properly recycled and do not end up in landfill, we offer a service where if you cover the cost of sending the products back to us, we will organise for the different materials to be separated and recycled properly.
